What an exciting time for SUUS! The congregation has come through the worst of the COVID pandemic. You're about to have a new minister who is joyfully looking forward to an open-ended future with you. It's a perfect time to re-imagine faith formation, both for our children and youth, and for adults—those already among you and those who will join you in the year ahead.

At this great time in SUUS' life, it is more important than ever to support your best aspirations for your religious home with a fair share financial pledge.

Perhaps pledging is new to you. Let me say this: it's not like buying a gym membership or making a modest donation to an organization whose work you admire. No, this is your community of belonging, of personal and spiritual growth, of a kind of mutuality and love like no other.

Some people tithe, that is, they automatically pledge 10% of their adjusted income. This is true in many traditions, rich or poor or in-between. SUUS asks you to aim first for 5% or more of your "net net", adjusted income as it appears on your federal tax form minus vital family commitments that tax laws do not account for.

Follow this 5% SUUS plan, or tithe if you feel called to a bigger stretch—and I hope some of you will. This is the perfect year to give to your religious home as much as you possibly can. Your sense of commitment will increase. Your sense of connection to SUUS' mission will multiply. Whether we are talking \$100 or \$10,000 or some amount in-between, the future is now!
